

PUBLIC HEARINGS

PROHIBITING PARKING ON OSBORNE STREET

REMOVING ONE (1) ON-STREET PARKING SPACE ON GROVE STREET AT WHARF STREET

Manager Mills stated that the reason for removing the parking space was to improve visibility and safety at the intersection. Councilmember Parks added that the space was illegal because cars had to back into the intersection.
