Public hearings were held before the Loudon City Council on June 20, 2016 in the Council Meeting Room. Those present for the all of the public hearings were: Mayor Jim Greenway, Councilmen Lynn Millsaps and Dennis Stewart. Also present were City Manager Lynn Mills and City Recorder Stephanie Putkonen. Attorney Kris Frye was present representing City Attorney Joe Ford. Councilman Harris and Councilman Johnny James were present for the third hearing. There were five people present for the first public hearing, six people present for the second public hearing and twenty-two present for the third public hearing. The press was not represented.

APPROVING AMENDMENT SEVEN TO THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT CONTINUING THE PLANNING AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT
